Ashleigh Luca Tyson Bio

Ashleigh has been a dressage competitor for over 20 years, competing in her 1st Canadian National Championship at the age of 10. Coached by her Mother, Leslie Steele, Ashleigh was a very successful competitor winning numerous championships, including Provincial, Regional and National Championships in Canada from Training through to Medium and JR. F.E.I. levels. Ashleigh was the first ever Canadian National JR. F.E.I. Champion in Canada in 1999, when the tests were first introduced to North America.

Ashleigh worked on the family farm throughout her high school years. Westwind Farm North has both racing and performance horses. Ashleigh's mother has coached professionally for over 30 years, her father David has bred and run thoroughbred race horses for over twenty years. As part of the Westwind team, Ashleigh has been responsible for mare and foal care, stallion handling, breaking and training of young stock and riding instruction. The farm often had more than forty head of horses that are boarded and managed.

After graduating Ashleigh accompanied her mother's coach, Canadian Olympian Leslie Reid to Germany to work in the barn of German Master Udo Lange and Canadian Olympic Dressage rider, Chrisilot Boylen. After six months in Europe Ashleigh returned home to compete and work with her parents on the farm. Leslie Reid arranged for Ashleigh to compete on Jill Whitehead's F.E.I. gelding Ivor. After a very successful summer Ashleigh went once again with Leslie for the winter months to train and compete in Arizona and California.

Ashleigh enjoyed a very successful California CDI tour, winning the Rancho Murieta CDI Young Rider division and placing ninth in the Los Angeles CDI in the OPEN Prix St. George and Intermediare I. Ashleigh finished the season with qualified scores for Pan American Games and NAJRYR Championships and as the leading Canadian Young Rider.

At the age of 19, Ashleigh became short listed with Ivor for Canadian Dressage Team in 2003 and then again in 2004. Since then, Ashleigh has competed in the FEI ring on her own horse, Lombardi LA and on Susan Wong's Nero, on her horse Uniek, owned with Partner and sponsor Sally Williams, on Cathy Heitel's Fabiano achieving scores up to the mid 70's.

In 2009, Ashleigh had an extremely successful season on Uniek, an eight year old KWPN gelding by Gribaldi, found for Ashleigh by her coach Steffen Peters. The pair had a very strong showing at Del Mar in September, where Uniek earned a score of 70.89 at the Prix St. George, finishing second and debuting his Intermediare I and winning the class. Ashleigh and Uniek finished the 2009 season with two more shows and two more scores of 71 and 74.4 % in the Prix St George and I1. In 2010, the pair finished Top 3 at the Del Mar National CDI3* behind their coach, Steffen Peters aboard Weltino's Magic, with scores of 67-69% in the Small Tour Division of the CDI and the I1 Freestyle.

Ashleigh hopes to continue her regular training and competing, with the tutelage and support of Team Peters, and with her new partners: Wellknown, a 5 year old Westphalen Gelding by Wynton that was imported for her by sponsor Alison Swanson; and San Soucis K, a 5 year old Oldenburg mare by Sir Donnerhall sponsored by River Oaks Farm. Ashleigh is a permanent resident of the USA and currently runs her own business, Westwind South Dressage in Scottsdale, AZ, where she trains and teaches Amateurs, Young Riders and other professionals from the lower levels all the way through the Grand Prix.

Ashleigh is married to Patrick Tyson, and the two of them have a young daughter, Addison Linden.

Spaces for the clinic will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Limited rider spots are available so register early.

CLINIC SERIES: We are planning a series of clinics with Ashleigh. Check http://www.unityequestrian.ca/Events_Clinics.html or contact Tammie for more details. Please advise if you are interested in future dates.

CLINIC COST: One day option is \$125 plus a portion of expenses. Two day option (Saturday and Sunday only) is \$250 plus portion of expenses. Three day option (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) is \$375 plus portion of expenses. This does include one 3-day auditor pass, and does not include stabling or arena haul-in fees. The actual costs for flights and expenses will be divided between the riders. We are striving to keep costs as low as possible.

AUDIT: Auditors are welcome. Each clinic rider may audit at no additional charge, and is entitled to one additional 3-day auditor pass for an accompanying party. Audit fees are \$15/day or \$40/3-day pass.

CANCELLATION POLICY: After registration, if you need to cancel it will be your responsibility to help find a replacement; however, please notify us if you are unable to attend as we will do our best to help you find a replacement.

FACILITY FEE: The clinic will be held at Eagle Hill Equine, located 25 minutes NW of Olds, or 25 mins SW of Bowden. This facility has a beautiful 100'x200' indoor arena. Eagle Hill Equine will charge a haul-in rider fee of \$10 per ride. See their website at www.EagleHillEquine.com

STABLING: Stabling is available (box stalls) at Eagle Hill Equine at a cost of \$25 per day/night. Shavings are included. Riders are responsible for feeding and watering their horse while on site. Bring your own feed and water bucket.

CAMPING: Camping is available on the grounds at Eagle Hill Equine for a fee of \$10 per night with no hookups, or \$15 per night with electricity only. Limited hookup spots are available.

ARRIVAL: All riders and auditors are required to sign Eagle Hill Equine facility waivers. Auditors will be expected to complete registration forms and pay auditing fees on arrival.
